Performance Commentary

The 5 Oceans Fund had a strong month up 2.33% in March.

This was mainly driven by the global strategies, with Schroder gaining 5.9% and Acadian up 9.6%. Both Acadian and Schroder are unhedged returns and the currency hedges in place tempered some of the returns, contributing -0.8% this month. Our local strategies were mixed contributors, with Ranger down 0.7% and Trans-Tasman up 2.0%.

The bond strategies navigated rising interest rates very well with T Rowe Price up 1.2% (due in part to negative duration positioning in the US), whilst Daintree was flat and the direct bond holdings up 0.1%. The Kohinoor tail risk strategies were down overall, with the Core fund down 4.1% (in USD) and the Pacific fund flat (in AUD).

Fund Strategy

The 5 Oceans Fund is designed to have a diversified asset and geographic exposure. The exposure to growth assets can be varied between 30% and 70% of the fund depending on the underlying managers' assessment of market risk. This is quite different from traditional diversified funds which often target a set growth allocation and invest accordingly.

The fund achieves this by carefully selecting managers that have flexible investment mandates and/or employ risk mitigation strategies. This gives the fund a dynamic and flexible exposure to growth assets and greater focus on capital protection in the event of market crashes.

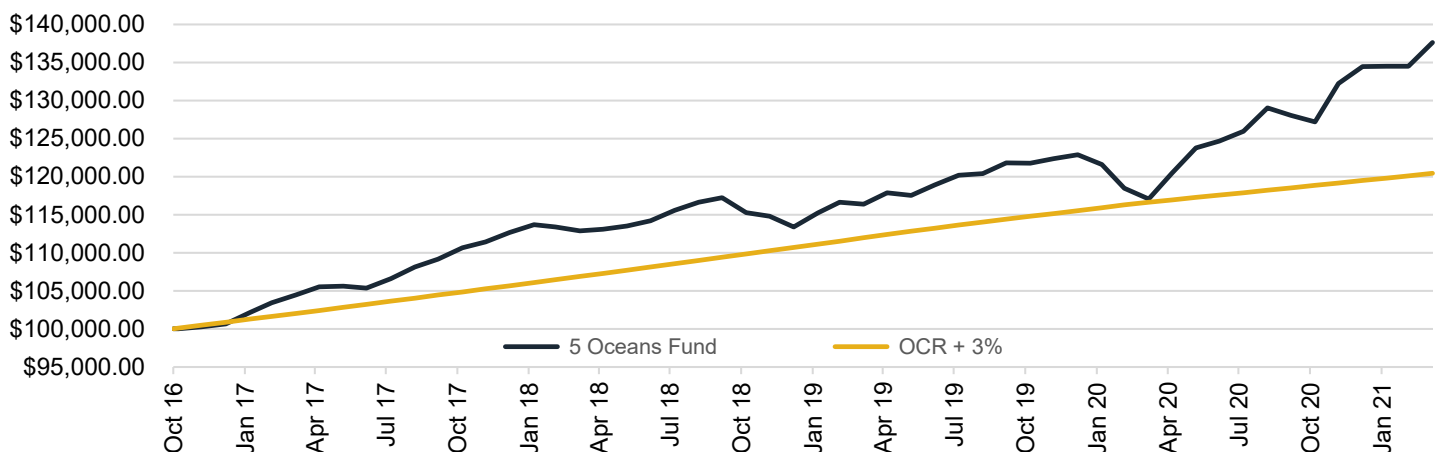

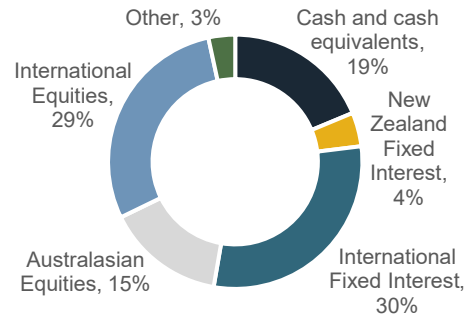
