



## Trans-Tasman Fund

### Performance Commentary

The Trans-Tasman Fund was up 0.72% in May, whilst the S&P/NZX50 benchmark was up 1.04%.

It was a quiet month in terms of news for the overweight positions of the fund. The most significant news came from Boom Logistics. Weather and bushfires in Australia have delayed work on wind farms where Boom's cranes were erecting wind turbines. In our opinion, the contracts remain profitable but some revenue has been deferred to the following accounting period resulting in a modestly lowered 2019 earnings guidance. In response to this, Boom's shares traded down 16% which resulted in Boom being the largest detractor for the fund over the month of May.

### Portfolio Strategy

The Castle Point Trans-Tasman Fund invests in New Zealand and Australian Listed Companies and is benchmarked to the S&P/NZX 50 Index. The objective of the Portfolio is to outperform the benchmark over rolling three year periods. With its high active share the Portfolio targets a tracking error of between 3-6% and will typically have less than 5% in cash at any time.

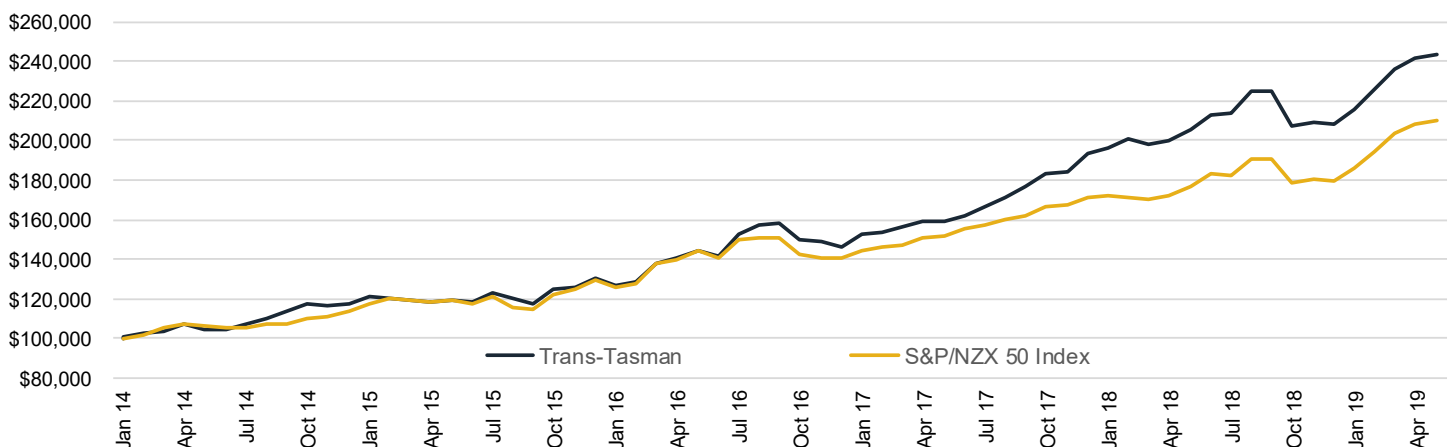

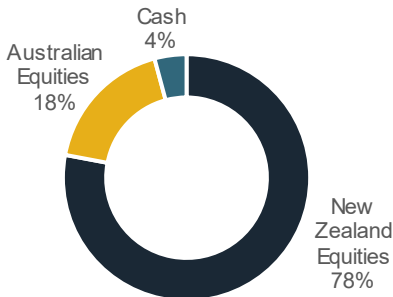

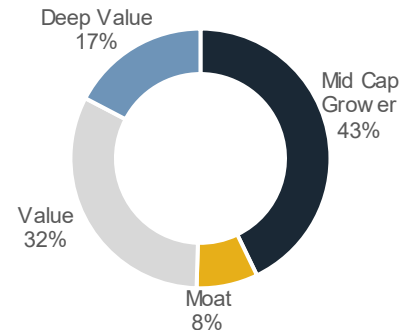
